Biblical Backing ~ Your Best Bet for Being Human

Have you ever wondered how scripture supports, encourages, and guides our lives here on Earth? When Life Coach, Dr. Cherie Carter-Scott, published the Rules for Being Human in the 1970's they were secular, in other words ~ nonreligious. After reading the list, I immediately consulted my Bible to find scriptures that demonstrate God's touch and influence upon six of the rules from this list.
